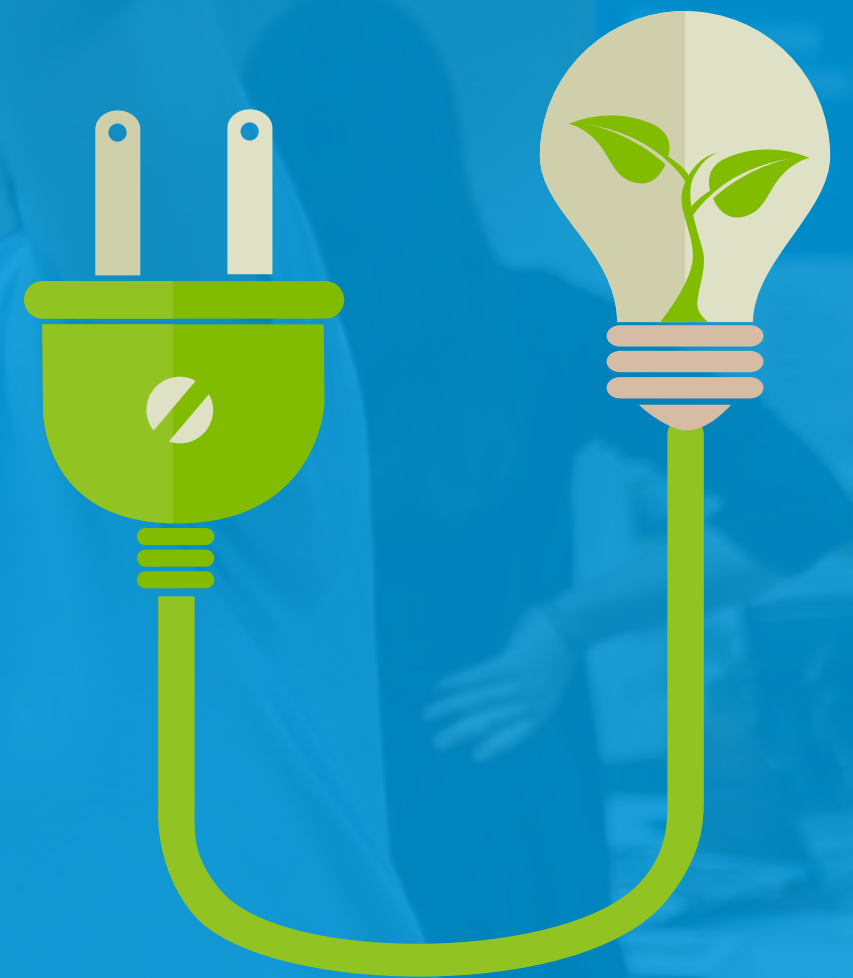


# RISE STOCKTON

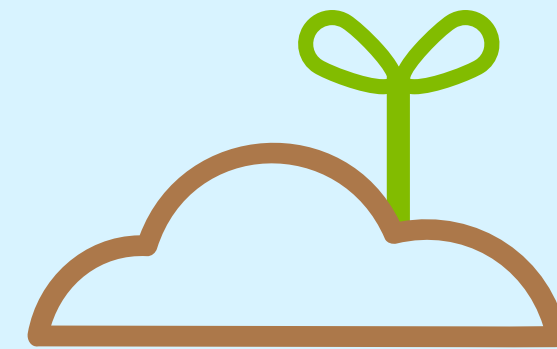
