Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) Program

Low-cost financing to support resiliency projects for critical facilities

Available Funding: \$25 million

- Supporting communities by providing back up power to critical facilities
- **Launch:** Public sector - March 23, 2020; Private Sector - TBD

Project Sunshine

Solar on Low-Income Housing

Incentive Amount: \$5,000 per home

Launch: 2018

Results: No-cost solar for 20 homeowners

Residential Resiliency Program

Incentives for back-up generation to support MBCP's most vulnerable residential customers

Status: Under development

Anticipated Launch: Fall 2020

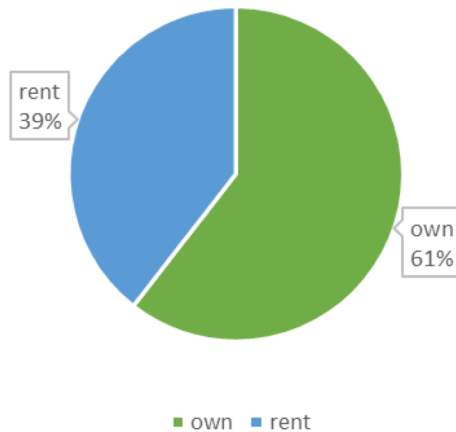
Residential Survey

- Received 456 responses
- Who has back up power?

- How much are they willing to spend on back-up power?

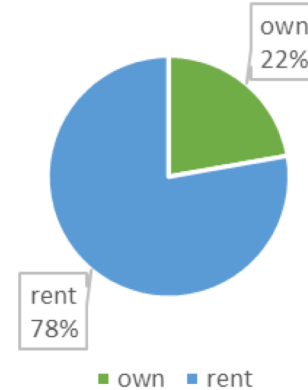
75% of customers surveyed do not have back up power

Where do the respondents live?

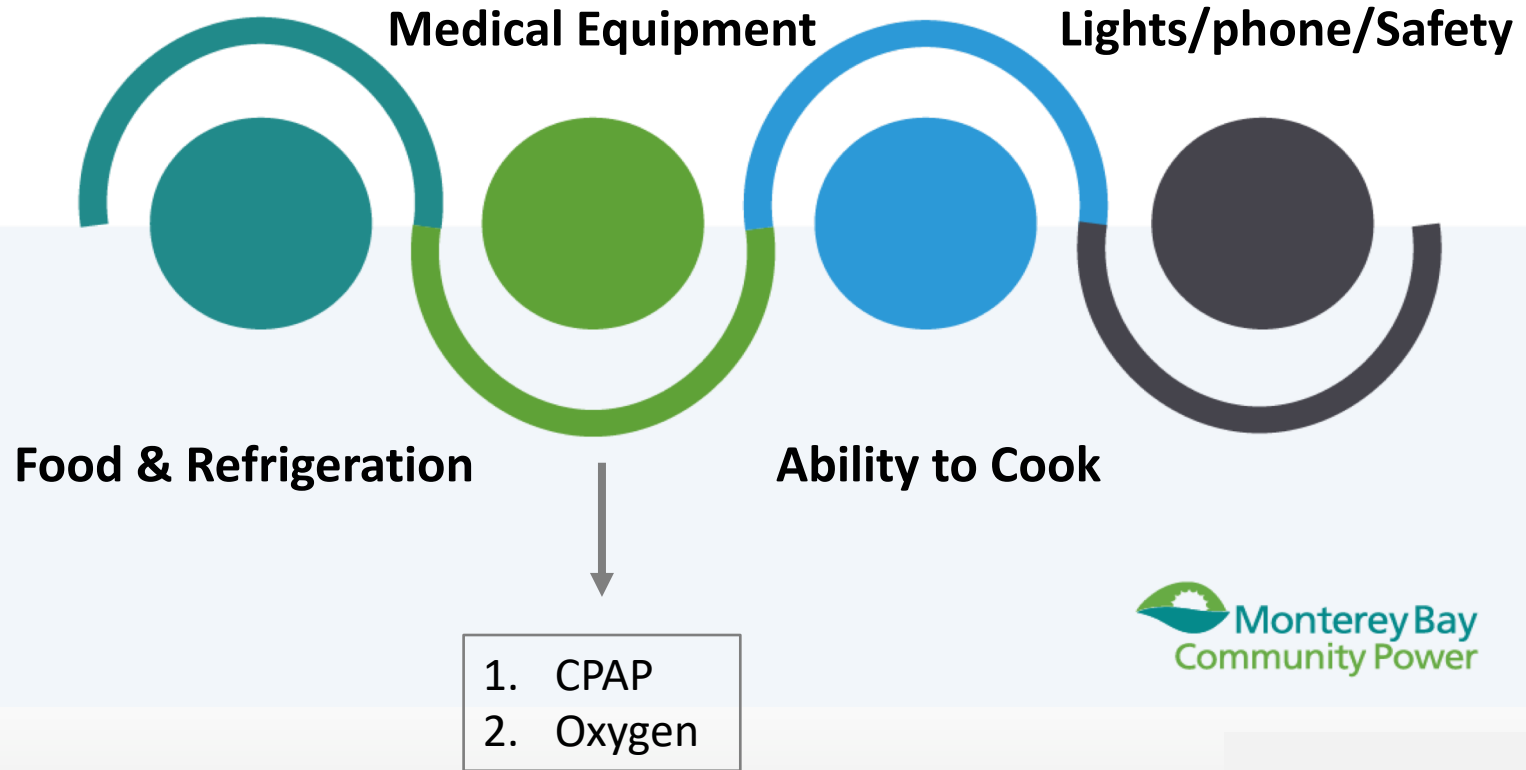
Spanish and English Speaking Respondents
