Affordability Crisis

- In 2024...
 - PG&E had SIX rate increases
 - All for-profit investor-owned utilities made record, or near-record, profits
 - Thousands of households were disconnected due to affordability
- High bills =
 - Worsening the housing crisis
 - Barrier to climate goals

Solutions:

- Public financing
- Reduce the rate base
- Clamp down on utility overspending
- Increase transparency and accountability

 - AB 1167 (Asms. Berman and Addis)
 - SB 24 (Sen. McNerney)
 - SB 330 (Sen. Padilla)
- Immediate relief
 - SB 636 (Sen. Menjivar)
